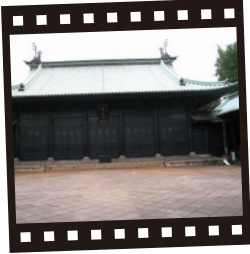


Filming locations walking course map

The largest book town in Japan, with its ambience of the good old Showa period (1926–89) and historical buildings, is a big attractor of film crews. The Yushima-seido Temple nearby is also a well-known location used in various TV dramas.

1 Yushima-seido Temple (Yushima, Bunkyo-ku)

Featured in Various TV dramas

Built in 1690 by the 5th shogun Tokugawa Tsunayoshi, the Yushima-seido Temple serves as the location for various TV dramas. It is also known to have special powers that help visitors achieve academic success.

Curry Rice Ethiopia is a popular restaurant where the drama's main character, Akira, wants to join the line of customers waiting to get a taste of the specialty curry rice. It serves curry made from a dozen different spices, and which can be prepared up to 70 times spicier on request.

One of the movie's settings is the book town of Kanda Jimbo-cho, featuring the Seishindo-shoten Bookstore with its façade of yellow glazed "scratch tile" similar to that employed in the former Imperial Hotel.

Nakano-shoten Bookstore offers a lesson in the history of bookbinding with its lineup of scrolls, manuscripts, and books produced by early woodblock printing. All the books that appear in the fictional Morisaki Bookstore are the real store's real products.
