KODAIRA GREEN ROAD

Located approx. 25 minutes by train from Shinjuku station, Kodaira is a city within the Tokyo Metropolis that is easily accessible from central Tokyo. Within Kodaira is a 21km stretch of greenery called the Kodaira Green Road, which is comprised of the Tamagawajosui Aqueduct, the Nobidome Canal, Sayama Sakai Green Way, and Koganei Park. The Kodaira Green Road is a gorgeous, virtually flat area that's great for enjoying nature and has been selected as one of the 100 most scenic waterside roads by the television program *Shin Nihon Aruku Michi Kiko* (*New Journey Walking the Roads of Japan*). Its location is perfect for day trips from central Tokyo.

Komorebi Footbath

Location on map : A-2

A free footbath facility located alongside the Tamagawajosui Aqueduct. The footbaths use soft groundwater and provides a relaxed, open atmosphere. Fall naturally into friendly conversation with the person sitting beside you. In addition to two roofed footbaths, there is also a foot pressure point (massage) course and hand baths. CAZE CAFÉ

Location on map : A-2

Step down a back street off the Tamagawajosui Aqueduct and discover an open-air café where the breeze is pleasantly refreshing. Operated by the social welfare service organization TOKIWAKAI, this café serves bread, pastries, and scones baked fresh every morning by people with disabilities. Having won various prizes for their sweet breads and pastries, the café's food quality and taste is guaranteed. Irori no Sato

This long-established Japanese style restaurant located next to the Tamagawajosui Aqueduct was reopened in March 2019 after undergoing renovation. A very unique service is offered guests can receive their meal via a 1/12 th scale steam locomotive. In addition to the "Sato course" (3500yen plus tax) which includes locally produced chicken and specially selected pork, guest s can also choose seafood or domestically produced rib roast courses. Kodaira Hirakushi Denchu Art Museum

Location on map : B-6

An art museum exhibiting the works of Hirakushi Denchu, a master of modern Japanese sculpture. In addition to the artworks on display, you can also see the house where Denchu lived in his twilight years, gaining a sense of the artist's life and spirit. The calligraphy pictured is Denchu's own work. The museum has also preserved various famous sayings by Denchu, such as Roku-ju, Nana-ju wa Hanatare Kozo, Otokoza kari wa Hyaku kara Hyaku kaka "At 60 and 70, a man is still a sniffing boy; he is not in his prime until after 100". In spring and autumn, tea parties are held in the garden of Denchu's former home (see Kodaira no Shiki). ●ADMISSION: 300 yen ●OPEN: 10:00-16:00 ●CLOSED: Tuesdays ●ADDRESS: 1-7-5 Gakuen Nishimachi, Kodaira City ☎042-341-0098

Edo-Tokyo Open Air Architectural Museum

Location on map :B-8

This outdoor museum displays 30 historical buildings dating from the Edo Period (1603-1867) to the mid Showa Period (1945-1964) that have been relocated from throughout Japan. Come see the Takei Sanshodo stationary store which has a drawer covered wall that was used as inspiration for the boiler room that appears in the Studio Ghibli film Spirited Away. Travel back in time by walking along the Shitamachi Nakadori street, which is lined with buildings constructed during the Showa period. 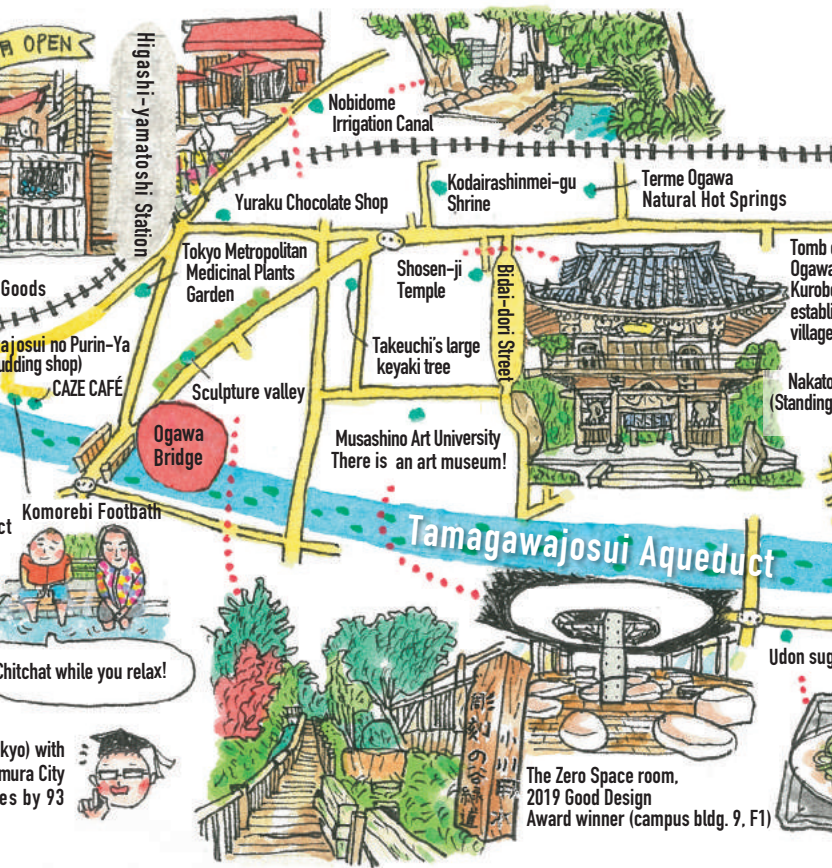
Tamagawajosui Aqueduct

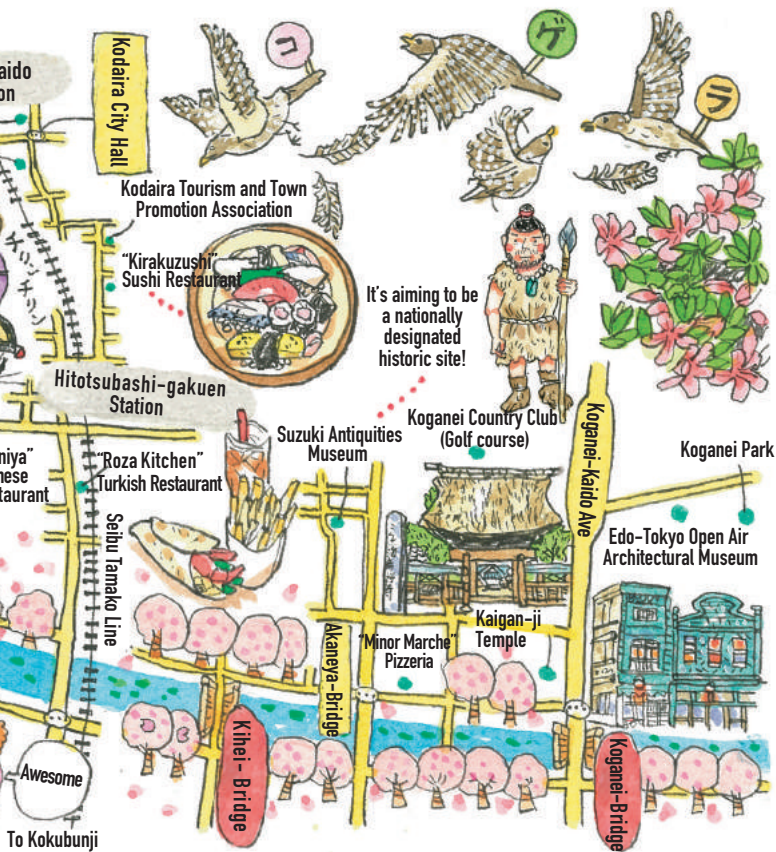

Tokyo Metropolitan Medicinal Plants Garden

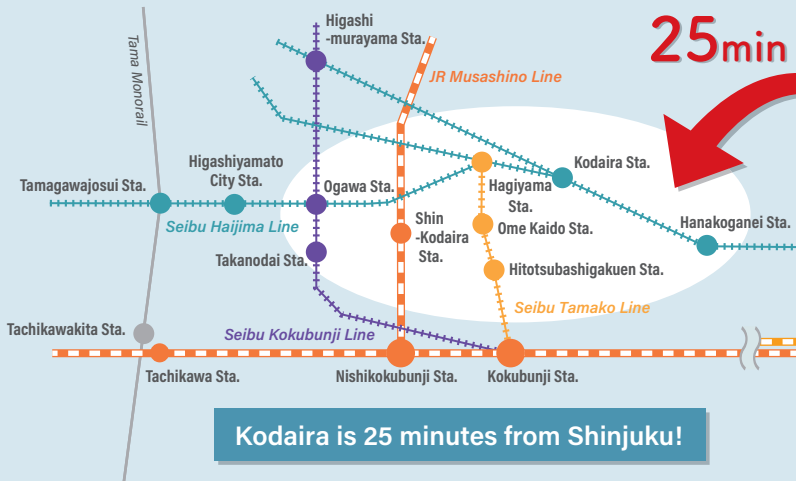

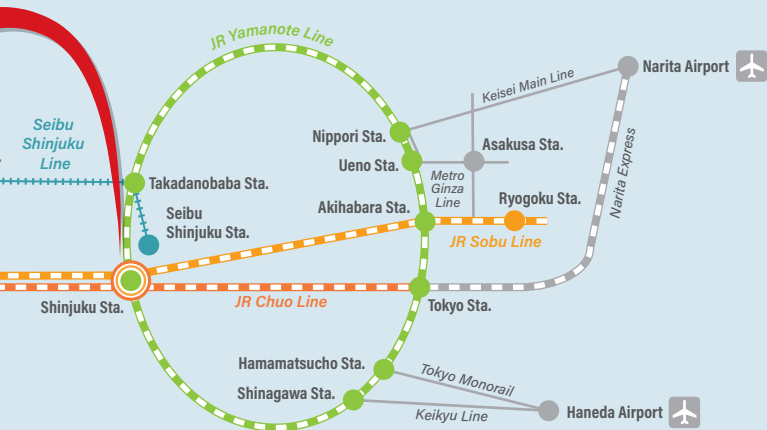
