

Participants visit five temples and two Jizodo in the Akigawa Keikoku Valley area to pray for good fortune. This event is held each year from January 1 to 3 from 9am to 4pm. At Musashi-Itsukaichi Station and each venue, you can get a Seven Lucky Gods memorial page (300 yen), memorial seal imprint (stamp/each venue 200 yen).



Akiru-jinja Shrine's festival features more than about 400kg hexagonal portable shrines.








# Famous Produce


