Special Captain Tsubasa buses are found on the national highway route near the Yotsugi Medakano Komachi Lane and on Myroad Yotsugi Shotengai Shopping Street.

1 Statue of Ishizaki Ryo
Invigorates the team with his vigorous play full of fighting spirit and courage. He is famous for his "GAMMEN BLOCK" (face-blocking) technique, which stops opponents shooting. **5min.**

2 Statue of Hyuga Keijiro
A genius striker who never ceases battering himself. He is famous for his dynamic ability to blow through the field and his strong shooting skills. He is called "MOCHIKO (Power Tiger)" because of his powerful and fierce lightning spirit. **5min.**

3 Statue of Ozora Tsubasa
Captain Tsubasa is a growing success story of the main character of the manga. Ozora Tsubasa, has created unprecedented football popularity. As a milestone of football manga, Captain Tsubasa continues to entertain people around the world. **6min.**

4 Statue of Robert Heno and Ozora Tsubasa
Roberto Heno is a Japanese Brazilian and a former Brazilian national football player who is also a mentor to Ozora Tsubasa. He is captivated by Tsubasa's talent and watches him grow while sparing him on "Viva Tsubasa!" **9min.**

5 Statue of Nakazawa Sanao
Sanao fell in love with Ozora Tsubasa at first sight, and supports the football team to cheer for him as a member of the cheerleading team with her strong leadership skills. **9min.**

- a** Craftwork by artisans in Katsushika City is sold directly at "Dento Sangyo Kaikan," A craftwork class is held once a month.
- b** The shrine crest is a three-tooled *yatagarasu* (a mythical raven). The *yatagarasu*, enclosed in a pentagon, has achieved fame as the logo of the Japanese national football team.
- c** In 1914, a large celluloid factory was established in this area, which resulted in the development of surrounding areas as a celluloid industry town. "The Kewpie Doll" is a famous example of a celluloid doll.



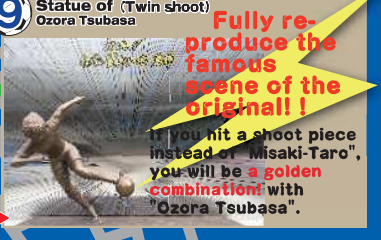
5 Statue of Nakazawa Senzo

A child of football who dreams of studying in Brazil aiming to become a professional football player with the goal of being the world's best for Japan. "Ball is a friend" is a creed.

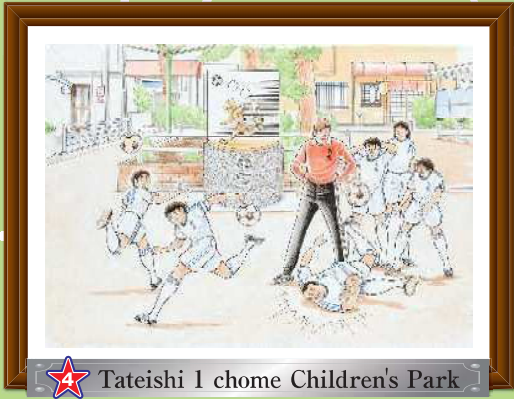
8 Statue of Wakabayashi Genzo
