



A discount ticket for visitors from abroad (Tokyo Subway Ticket) is also available. You can ride trains on the nine Tokyo Metro lines and four Toei Subway lines.



How to Use the Ticket チケットの使い方

Please insert your ticket into the slot at the ticket gate. It doesn't matter whether you insert it facing up or down. Pass through the gate and your ticket will come out of the slot on the other side. **Be sure to take it with you.** When you get off the train and leave the subway station, repeat the same process. Please note that some ticket gates are only for use with transportation IC cards and Tokyo Subway Tickets cannot be used with them.

PASMO is a convenient reloadable, prepaid transportation IC card that allows its users to ride Tokyo Metro subways and most trains and buses within Japan.

Where to Purchase and Recharge the Card

How to Use the Card

カードの使い方



Just touch the IC card reader on the ticket gate with your PASMO card. One advantage of using PASMO is that it lets you easily pay fares without having to calculate costs each time you want to go somewhere.



There is no expiration date for the PASMO card (It will be invalid if not used for more than 10 years from the date of last usage).

You can use PASMO to ride not only Tokyo Metro subways but also most trains and buses throughout Japan.

If the PASMO Card Is No Longer Needed

PASMO が不要になった場合

Any remaining balance for stored fares (SF) and ¥500 deposit are returned to the user.

$$\text{Amount of money returned to the user} = \text{SF (remaining balance)} * 1 + \text{¥500 deposit} * 2$$

*1 The stored fare (SF) is the amount of money left on the PASMO card (remaining balance of money placed on the card).

*2 The ¥500 deposit is an amount paid separately at the time of purchase that cannot be used as stored fare for paying transportation fees or for shopping.

Fares

運賃について

The fares for the Tokyo Metro lines vary depending on the type of ticket you use.

Regular Tokyo Metro tickets are available in amounts of ¥170, ¥200, ¥250, ¥290, and ¥320, increasing with the distance of travel.

For prepaid transportation IC cards such as the PASMO card, a fee of ¥168, ¥199, ¥242, ¥283, or ¥314 is charged, increasing with the distance of travel.



Fare Categories According to Age

運賃の年齢区分

Adult: Age 12 and up

*However, the child fare may apply to any 12 year old who is still in elementary school in Japan.

Child: Age 6 to 11

*However, any 6-year-old preschooler who will enter elementary school in Japan may be considered a toddler. (The child fare is half of the adult fare. Figures are rounded up to the nearest 10-yen unit, or rounded down to the nearest 1-yen unit if an IC card is used.)

Toddler: Age 1 to 5

Up to two toddlers travel free provided they are accompanied by an adult or a child. However, a third toddler will be charged the child fare. Also, if a toddler is traveling alone or as part of a group, the child fare will be charged.

Infant: Free of charge if under age 1


