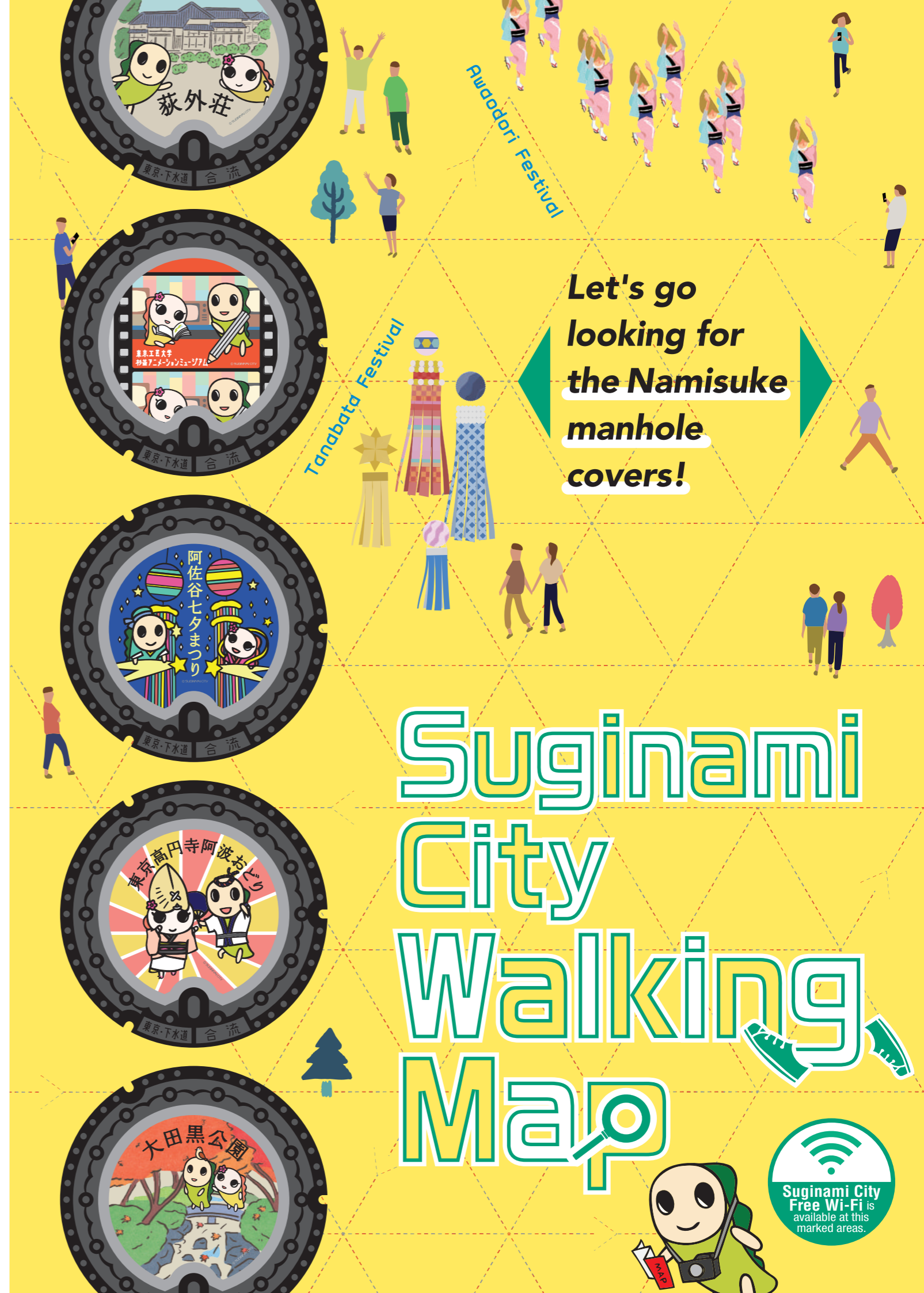
- Sessions last for 60 minutes. Wi-Fi is provided for your use without daily usage restrictions.
- In the event of a major disaster, registration is not required for Wi-Fi access.

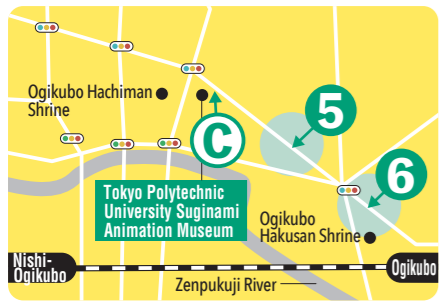

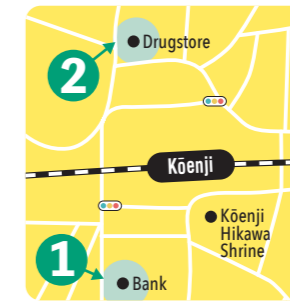
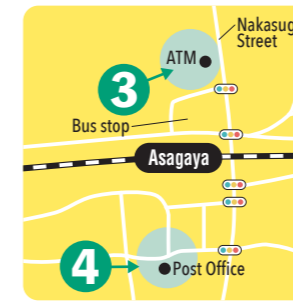




Recommended walking route

• Some detail is omitted for ease of understanding.

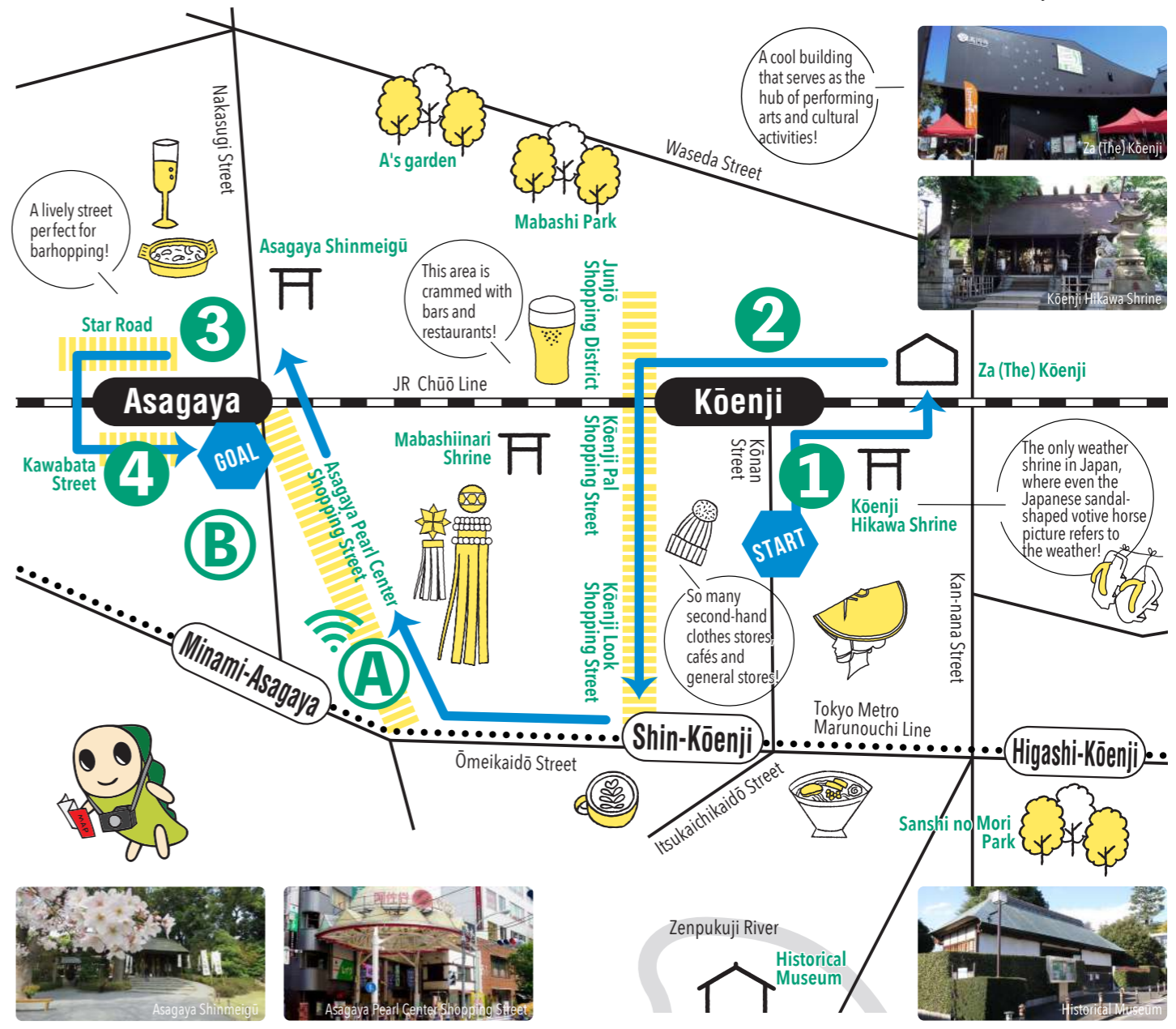
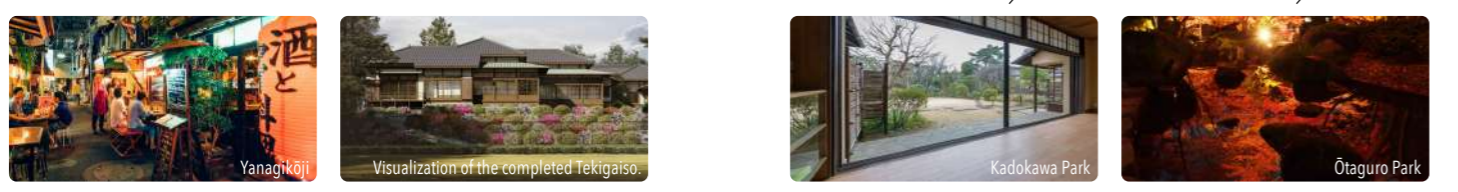
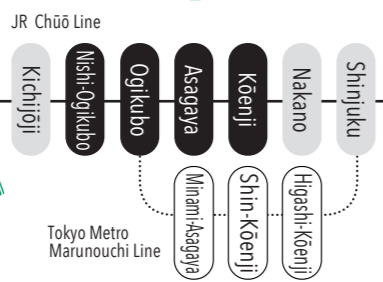
Ogikubo and Nishi-Ogikubo AREA
