## **1** Togoshi Park

戸越公園/豊町2-1-30

MAP B-3

A Japanese traditional garden with a path around the pond in the centre (Chisen-kaiyushiki-teien) and a playground. Enjoy the seasonal

beauty of the socalled Himalayan cherry blossoms in winter, the red maple leaves in autumn, and illumination.

## 2 Togoshi Hachiman-jinja Shrine



This wooden shrine with a traditional Japanese atmosphere was built in the late Edo period. A statue of a monkey which is said to be an incarnation of a Japanese God, and a statue of a cute rabbit. Touching them will bring happiness. (Open 9:00 - 16:00) 2-6-23 Togoshi, Shinagawa City

## 3 Horen-ji Temple

法蓮寺/旗の台3-6-18

Build in the mansion of a descendant of the Ebara family who ruled the land in olden times. The temple worships one of the Seven Deities - a god of wealth. Get a glimpse of a wonderful spring landscape with cherry blossoms and a traditional rock garden. 3-6-18 Hatanodai, Shinagawa City



# 4 Koyama Hachiman-jinja Shrine

小山八幡神社/荏原7-5-14

It is said to be founded around the time of the Kamakura Shogunate. According to an informal source, in 1030 the shrine worshiped a clan deity "ujigami" in the main village of the former Oyama Village. As



the name Oyama implies, it is the highest point in the Shinagawa City (35 m above sea level) with a beautiful view that has been chosen as one of A hundred views of Shinagawa. 7-5-14 Ebara.




Tea selections by a local expert and tea confectionary. The store is filled with the aroma of roasted green tea (hojicha).


