

Flowering dogwood Flowering dogwood is a deciduous broad-leaved tree of the family Cornaceae, native to North America.] The flowering dogwood came to Japan in 1915 as a gift from the City of Washington to the City of Tokyo in return for their gift of cherry trees, and served as a bridge for international exchange. Mature trees reach 5 to 7 meters in height. White and pink flowers bloom in spring, and the tree's red berries and

red leaves are beautiful in the fall, attracting small birds. City flower: Hydrangea IA deciduous broad-leaved tree of the family Saxifragaceae, native to Japan (southern Kanto region).]

Types of hydrangea include the gaku hydrangea and the tama hydrangea. nis plant has been growing wild in the Kanto region since ancient times. The color



This temple is the family temple of the Asano Clan, rulers of Ako Domain during the Edo period. Graves on the site include those of Asano Naganori Asano Naganori (titled Takumi no Kami) set off the events leading to the Chushingura, the incident involv ing the Ako Gishi (known abroad as the 47 ronin), and their graves are also in the temple grounds.
