# **GETTING HERE**

#### By Train

The Studio Tour's nearest railway station is Toshimaen and direct services arrive there from Ikebukuro on the Seibu-Ikebukuro Line (20 minute journey). The station is also accessible on Metro 'Toei Oedo line'.

#### By Car

To travel by car, exit the Tokyo Gaikan Expressway at "Oizumi I.C." and onto Mejiro Street to the Studio Tour. Parking spaces are limited and must be booked in advance. To avoid congestion, we recommend arriving by train.
