



Shioiri Park

Reeds along the Sumida River

Reeds have been planted along the riverside to help restore the river's natural environment. The area where the reeds were planted is where the water flows up to during the high tide, bringing crabs and other animals with it, making this the perfect place to enjoy observing a little bit of nature.

Sumida Park encompasses both Sakurabashi Bridge and Kototoibashi Bridge. Visitors can enjoy seeing the way the greenery gradually transitions to the urban atmosphere of the business buildings downstream of the Azumabashi Bridge. A number of highlights can be found along the river, such as Asakusa, with its old-fashioned feudal-era atmosphere; Mukojima, with the atmosphere reminiscent of an old-fashioned geisha town; and Mukojima Hyakkaen



Both the Azumabashi Bridge and Komagatabashi Bridge are popular places to see the Tokyo Skytree®.

Enjoy the red of Azumabashi Bridge, the blue of Komagatabashi Bridge, the green of Umayabashi Bridge, and the yellow of Kuramaebashi Bridge, as you walk around the area, taking in the area's varied bridges.

Simplified Pier

This pier for small boats is available for public use, making it a perfect meeting place. There are a total of four of these along the Sumida River: near the Kototoibashi, Azumabashi, Komagatabashi, and Kachidokibashi Bridges.






