in Tachikawa

14 Kumano Jinja Shrine

Founded in 1726 as the guardian shrine of Shibasaki Shinden (Shichikenyu). Receive blessings with a Yatagarasu amulet after your visit.

Stroll through ancient temple grounds.

16 Genbusan Fusaiji Temple

Founded in 1353, this temple boasts historical remnants like earthen walls and the Shibasaki irrigation canal, a must-see for history buffs.

15 min walk from JR Tachikawa Station

Cherry blossoms in spring, lotus flowers in early summer... flowers adorn the grounds throughout the four seasons. See the national treasure, Rokumen-sekito stone lantern and the monument marking the birthplace of school education.

18 GREEN SPRINGS

The spacious earthen floor and formal zashiki room are also highlights.

21 NOWCAL BAZAR/JIBAR CAFE

A wide variety of seasonal local vegetables, special products, and bread from bakeries in the city. Relax in the adjoining cafe after shopping.

22 Farmer's Center Minore Tachikawa
