




Welcome to Musashino city!

Musashino-shi is one of the fascinating towns representing metropolitan area. Many citizens are living here and lots of unique shops are gathering. The city has provided the settings for various literary works, art works, animated films and so on. It has kept offering enchantment and comfort for people to come together since long time ago. From ancient times, the area around Inokashira Pond has been a place of springing water. We found out from remains that many people had already gathered here, seeking rich harvest and hunting prey since the Kyu-Sekki (Old Stone) age and the Jomon period. The establishment of the town was in the early Edo Period by the people living in the vicinity of Suwasan-Kichijoji Temple in Suido-bashi, central Tokyo. The villages and towns formed in front of this temple was burnt down by the Great Fire of Meireki in 1675. Then the people living there moved here, naming it Kichijoji. They developed the Musashino plateau and formed 4 villages. In the Meiji period, a railroad was constructed, and eventually the town had expanded gradually. In the Taisho Period, Inokashira Park opened as the first suburban park in Japan, and has become one of popular outing spots. At the same period, the Kanto Great Earthquake prompted many people to move here from downtown Tokyo, and the town was urbanized guickly. In the early Showa Period, the leading manufacturer in Japan and said to be the largest in the East at that time, Musashino Plant of Nakajima Aircraft Manufacturing, was constructed. Then, people persevered in the trumoil of the post war, and the town has come to life again and still continues developing.



The area has various attractive elements such as fashion, gourmet, culture as well as nature. And this area within just 300 meters from the station is so convenient that people can enjoy all different kinds of activities; eating, shopping, or even relaxing in nature. This is one of the biggest reasons why this city has been ranked as one of the most "desirable city to live in" for many years. In addition to it, its unique culture and atmosphere have always inspired many creators in different fields such as anime or music, making the area somewhat the core of Japanese subculture.

Its development as commercial and residential area started sometime between the Edo and the Meiji period. One of the biggest factors in its growth was when many residents around the temple "Kichijoji" in the downtown Tokyo lost their homes in the Great Fire of Meireki. In search of a new place to live in, people started settling along Itsukaichi Kaido Road and named the area after the temple. After that, in 1899, Kichojoji Station opened, which made influence on the area's development. Also in 1923, due to the Great Kanto Earthquake, many people moved out of central Tokyo and settled around this area, which led the town urbanized. After war, black-market stalls appeared around the station and eventually the town has developed to the city what it is today.

Big department stores and Shōtengai, shopping streets, are one of the important elements which make Kichijoji so attractive. You may see various streets including the 300 meter-long shopping arcade of "Sun Road", right in front of Kichojoji Station North exit, "Daiya Gai" with popular dailydish shops, "Harmonica Yokocho" with an narrow alley where you may feel nostalgic atmosphere. There are more than that; "Heiwa Dori" with beautiful trees and "Nakamichi Dori" with a lot of unique, original stores and shops. They are all connected each other, yet each street has its own type of atmosphere. These stores and the big shopping facilities are supporting the citizen's lives and also attracting visitors from various places.

This urban oasis is surrounded by houses and shopping streets. Its pond is also famous for swan-shaped boats that families and couples are rowing relaxedly. The park also has many facilities where people of all ages can enjoy.

Inokashira Park Zoo is divided into a zoo area and an aquatic life area, covering roughly 35,000 square meters, exhibiting 4,000 animals of about 170 species. The park has an exhibition hall, a sculpture museum, an aquatic life house, Japanese garden, and so on. By entering the breeding cage, "Squirrel Trail", you can see Japanese squirrels up close.

About the area

Tamagawa Josui Canal, "Green Road"

Major facilities that support residents' everyday lives are concentrated in this area; such as the city hall, the police station, health care center, cultural hall, central library etc. At the same time, thuogh it is a quiet residential area, there are many major companies, restaurant chain headquarters, animation studios, etc., as well as places where you can relax in the lush greenery. At the rotary in front of the station (at the north exit of Mitaka Station), the World Federation Peace Statue by Seibo Kitamura, the first honorary citizen of Musashino-shi, welcomes visitors.

Talking of the history of this area, the Nakajima Aircraft Musashi Factory is what you cannot miss. Until the end of World War II, the factory was known as the largest military aircraft engine manufacturer in the East. From 1938 until the end of the war, it occupied the wide area stretching from Midori-cho to Yawata-cho (at present). It is said that Mitaka Station North Exit was constructed in 1941 for the factory workers. A part of the site of the factory is now changed to Musashino Chuo Park and the City Hall. The park is now known as the mecca of flying paper plane and has become the venue of paper plane meetings.

Hidden fun for families Musashino Clean Center

This is a cutting-edge garbage disposal plant. They are offering tours of the plant without any reservation. You can watch the disposal process through huge glass windows and learn how waste is being disposed during the tour. They also hold occasional events such as "Eco-Marche" and so on.

About the area

Musashisakai is a convenient place, rich in nature. Inside and around the station, there are many stores such as "nonowa" and "Ito-Yokado" where you can find all kinds of items you need. It also has many cultural facilities such as Musashino Place and Musashino Swing Hall, as well as universities like Asia University and Nippon Veterinary and Science University, giving an academic atmosphere to the area. In just a short walk from the station, you can find places rich in nature; Tamagawa Josui Canal, a wooded area commemorating Doppo Kunikida, and so on. Red peppers are a local specialty cultivated in this area.

History

There used to be a property of Matsudaira clan in Edo period. After completing the construction of Tamagawa Josui Canal, the land once owned by the clan was changed to rice field and was named after the surname of the clan's vassal, In 1889, Sakai Station (the current Musashisakai Station) was opened. After the war, the surrounding area has been urbanized, opened. Following the development of the area, many educational institutions were founded, which made the town academic. After the war, it was developed on a large scale as a residential area and has grown as a commuters' town.

Learn and relax Musashino Place

Musashino Place is a public facility which functions not only as a library but also as a space for lifelong learning, civic events and youth activities. It has been supporting the life and the activities of all ages. It was awarded for its comfortable and modern design in 2016 by the Architectural Institute of Japan. It also has a cozy café on the 1st floor.

1. Musashino-related **People of Culture**

Writers, composers and critics who had connections to the city

Known for its well-preserved nature, Musashino city has been inspiring many artists, poets and writers representing some of Japanese art since the end of the 19th century. They have gathered to create their works. Take a walk and find monuments related to them.



Monument of Doppo Ku nikida (Sakura Bridge)

A novelist in the late 19th century. He loved the scenery of the Musashino area. Doppo Kunikida

Doppo who was also a naturalist used to portray the beauty of Musashino's scenery in his works. Sakai Sanya Park, one of the forests he loved, still remains in the city and is now called as "Doppo-no Mori Forest" (Doppo's forest).

Ujo Noguchi was regarded as one of the three major lyricists of Japanese children's songs. Ujo spent about 20 years of his life in Kichijoji. In Inokashira Park Zoo, there are his study "Doshin-kyo" moved here and opened to the public, and the poetry monument of his relics "Inokashira Ondo".


What is MuBus?

MuBus is a local community bus mainly running through areas around Kichijoji Station, Mitaka Station North Exit and Musashisakai Sation. It offers seven different routes. The name MuBus came from rhym-

ing with "MOVE US" and also taking the "Mu" from Musashino. It's a small bus, 7 meters tall and 2 meters wide, which fits 29 people. It has been running since 1995 and it is 100 yen a ride.




Make a trip around Musashino-shi on a route bus!

Kanto Bus running in the city is offering a one-day ticket for 630 yen for an adult, and 320 yen for a child. How to buy the ticket: Upon riding the Kanto bus, ask the bus driver to register it on PASMO or Suica. Pay attention to your card balance so that the fare is deducted. As the bus routes include the ones connecting JR Chuo Line and Seibu Shinjuku Line, use the service for your convenience.





There are different ways to enjoy Musashino city whether examples, with specific distance and time required, of how you can use your day. They are all half-day courses and good for some relaxing walk.


