


Sumida City Visitors' Map



For getting around within Sumida City, the "Sumida Hyakkei Sumimaru-kun & Sumirin-chan" community buses are recommended. They operate on three routes—Northwest Route, Northeast Route, and South Route—from Oshiage Station. An affordable one-day unlimited ride ticket is also available.


