Medaka no Komichi (2-3-3 Yotsugi)




Tsubasa Ozora

Yotsugi Tsubasa Park (1-22-3 Yotsugi)



Kojiro Hyuga



A forward player who can do dynamic penetrating dribbles and powerful shots. Known as "Fierce Tiger" for his determination to fight, Kojiro Hyuga has many special moves, including the "Tiger Shot".

Ryo Ishizaki



Ryo Ishizaki is the first character in the story that the protagonist, Tsubasa Ozora, meets. He contributes to the team with his bold plays and is famous for his "face block" that repels opponents' shots.

Tsubasa Ozora (Heel Lift)



Heel lift is a technique in which the player floats the ball behind him and kicks it upwards with his heel to dodge the opponent. It is one of Tsubasa's signature moves and is used in important scenes within the series.

Genzo Wakabayashi



Genzo is the first rival to appear in front of Tsubasa and eventually becomes his ally in the national team, in which they aim to become the best in the world. Genzo is also known as the "S.G.K. (Super Great Goalkeeper)".

Tateishi Michihiroba (4-28-14 Tateishi)



Tsubasa Ozora (Twin Shot)



This statue imitates the "Twin Shoot" between Tsubasa and Taro Misaki. You can shoot together with Tsubasa next to his bronze statue by the school gate of Minami Katsushika High School, the alma mater of Mr. Yoichi Takahashi!
