Tsubasa Ozora (Twin Shot)

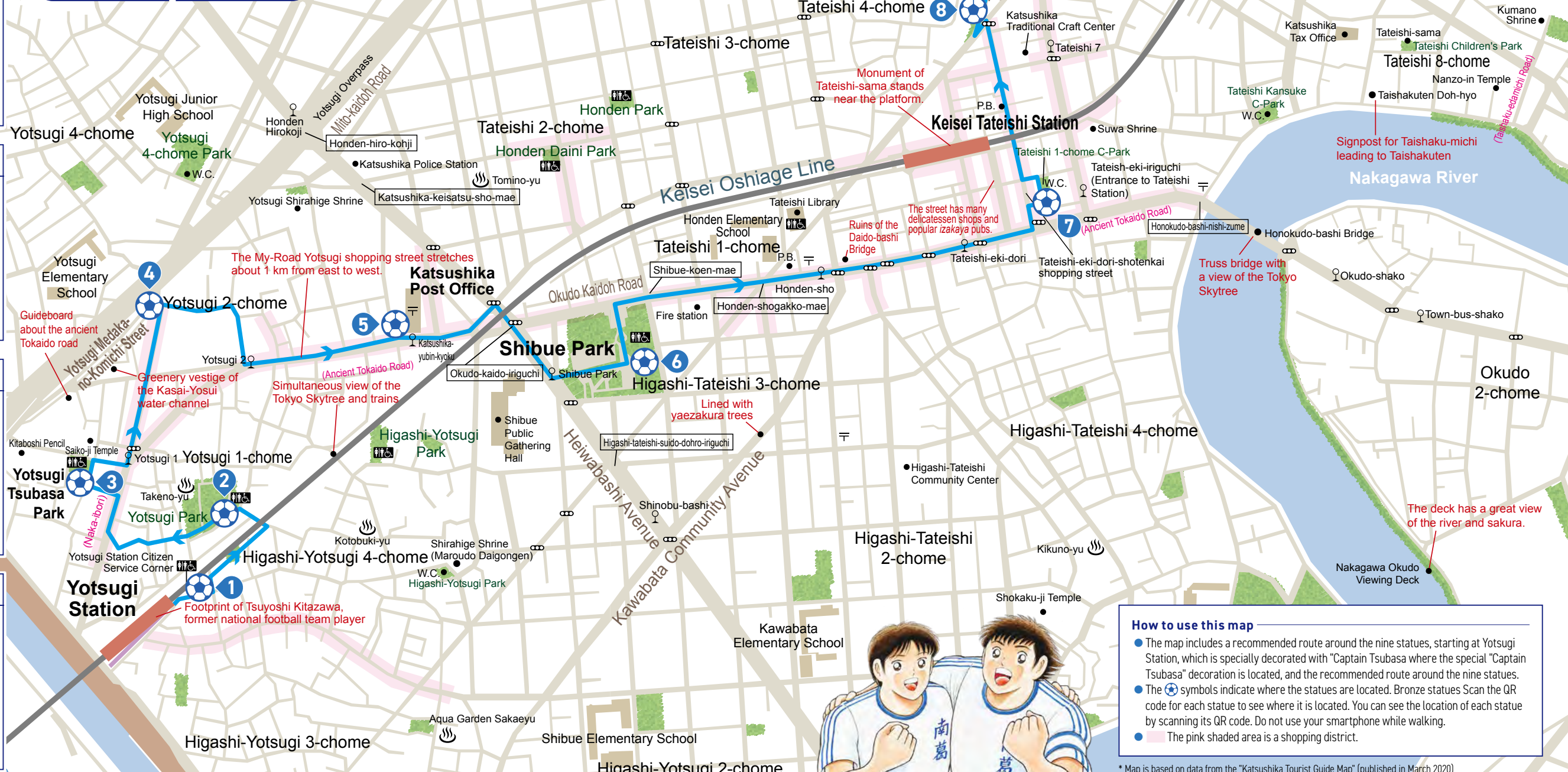

How to use this map

- The 🏈 symbols indicate where the statues are located. Bronze statues Scan the QR code for each statue to see where it is located. You can see the location of each statue by scanning its QR code. Do not use your smartphone while walking.
- The pink shaded area is a shopping district.
