

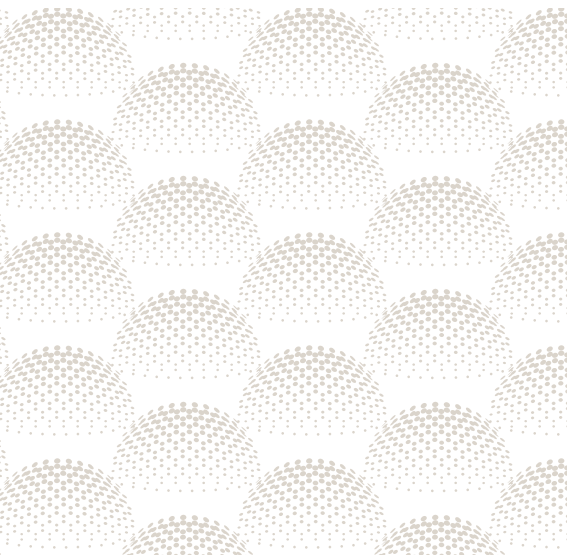

Superbly located opposite the Imperial Palace and Hibiya Park in Marunouchi district, and within minutes' walk of the shopping mecca of Ginza, The Peninsula Tokyo offers commanding views of the Japanese capital skyline. Modern and contemporary with Japanese accents, this gracious standalone hotel offers 302 spacious guestrooms, including 47 suites, eight unique restaurants and bar, four elegantly designed function rooms, a fitness center, indoor swimming pool, and the award-winning The Peninsula Spa & Wellness Center.

HOTEL ACCESS

The Peninsula Tokyo is directly connected to Hibiya Station, offering access to four major train lines - Hibiya, Chiyoda, Toei Mita and Yurakucho from exits A6 and A7. In addition, it is a two-minute walk from the JR Yurakucho Station, a three minute walk from Ginza station exit C4, and is a 10-minute taxi ride from Tokyo Station, making it the most accessible luxury hotel to explore the city.

- **Peter**, perched on the 24th floor of the hotel, offering modern French cuisine, and sweeping views of Tokyo's Imperial Palace.
- **Peter: The Bar**, is a refined destination where mixology becomes art. Savor original cocktails crafted with rare Japanese ingredients—each one a luxurious expression of precision, creativity, and terroir.
- **Hei Fung Terrace**, with a lavish interior reminiscent of an exotic Suzhou garden, and a menu featuring sophisticated Cantonese dishes.
- **The Lobby**, where the sparkling, fireworks-inspired chandelier overhead sets a magical scene for all-day dining, and Afternoon Tea accompanied by live music.
- **The Peninsula Boutique**, for enjoying an array of sweets and pastries, and special handmade Peninsula chocolates.
- **Zuicho**, where you experience a symphony of Japanese culinary artistry. The luxurious setting is the perfect location to enjoy the mastery of diverse cooking methods using only the finest ingredients.
- **Hibiya mon cher ton ton**, feast with your eyes and palate, as master chefs prepare meticulously sourced best of the best ingredients such as Kobe Beef, succulent seafood and seasonal vegetables, on a 'teppanyaki' iron plate.
- **Ten-ichi**, an internationally renowned tempura restaurant famous for its delicately fried tempura specialities made from the freshest seasonal ingredients.

Occupying the fifth and sixth floors of the hotel, The Peninsula Tokyo's 17,000-square-foot spa and fitness center provides a sanctuary of relaxation to guests.
